Greetings and thank you for electing to be a sponsor of the SAVMA 2010 Symposium at University of Wisconsin School of Veterinary Medicine.





Alternative Sponsorship Options:

Lecture: \$500 per lecture

Estimated 140 lectures evenly divided among the following topics: large animal, small animal, exotic and zoological medicine, behavior, alternative medicine, public health, business and career practices, lab animal medicine, diversity and miscellaneous topics
